Hands-On Cybersecurity: Exploitation and Pivoting

Obtaining illegitimate access to internal networks may require only a single, vulnerable point of entry. Adversaries exploit vulnerable hosts and use them as stepping stones to bypass firewalls, intrusion detection systems, and other defense mechanisms.

Through a practical exercise on a simulated network, participants will learn about the tools and methodologies that attackers use to pivot through networks and some defenses that can be used for protection and detection.
